- 1.- Use the different formats (styles) which are proposed in the upper-left corner of Microsoft Word (Text_1, Text_1a, etc.).
- 2.- Use the English style inverted commas: “”.
- 3.- Put footnotes exponents after punctuation marks.
- 4.- Do not use the tab key at the beginning of new paragraphs.
- 5.- Tables and figures must be both in the main text file AND in separate files (.jpg, .gif, .tiff etc.).
