- First Arabic Police Force to apply DNA testing in criminal investigations.
- First Arabic Police Force to use electronic finger printing.
- First Arabic department to know and implement the paperless department concept.
- Very first Police Force to utilize the Automatic Vehicle Locator(A.V.L) using Loran C signals in Gulf (in the mid-eighties even before many European and American countries used the same) and now it is the first to use satellite and GPS for Automatic Vehicle Locator(A.V.L).
- First Police Force to establish a Human Rights Department.
- First Police in the Arab World to apply electronic services.
