



Official Data:
 The City of Buenos Aires is the federal capital of the Argentine Republic. It extends upon a flat surface divided in 48 neighborhoods. It has approximately 3 million inhabitants who, together with the metropolitan area population which normally move in the City, exceed 10 million persons, which turns it into one of the ten most dynamic urban centers of the world.

Its limits: Río de la Plata and Riachuelo are its natural limits towards East and South. General Paz beltway, passing around the City from North to West, complete its limits. This avenue links the Capital with Buenos Aires outskirts in an express way.
